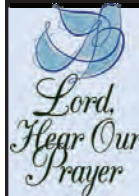

Beginning this summer, all Readers and

EMHCs who were originally mandated and completed their initial formation are invited by Bishop Caggiano to take one course every six months to maintain your authorization to serve. This is the case no matter when you earned your mandate. You should have received an email from the Institute for Catholic Formation.

When you log into LEAD - <https://bridgeport.leadlms.com/login> – you can enter your username and password and then click “ACADEMY” on the top of the page. [Side note: Your username is your email. If you forgot your password, just click “Forgot Password.”]

When you click Academy, you will see a track for your ministry – or two if you serve as both an EMHC and Reader. Once you click that track, you can add the course(s) you wish to take by clicking the +Add button.

You are only required to take ONE course every six months. If you do that, there will be no other requirement, except VIRTUS, of course, and any *get togethers* we may have during the year.

If you take more than one course per track, you might run out of courses in the future, so be careful about working ahead. If you have any questions you can click on this link

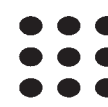
