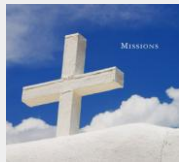

**Bishop Caggiano's July 8 statement
on the Dallas shootings**

Today our hearts ache with pain as we once again grapple with senseless violence and death in our nation. They ache for the brave and courageous police officers, gunned down in cold blood yesterday while protecting a peaceful protest and their families. Our hearts ache for the two men killed over the weekend, and for their families, who are left horrified and grief-stricken. They ache for the communities of Dallas, Baton Rouge and Minneapolis, for our black American brothers and sisters, for our police officers throughout the country and for all who have been deeply wounded by the scourge of violence in our midst. Let us join together to support all victims of violence and their families. Let us reach out in a spirit of compassion, consolation and understanding for all who are grieving today. As a people of faith, we must work fervently to end violence in every form throughout our country and prayerfully stand in solidarity with all who are working for justice, understanding, tolerance and peace.
