**Defending Our Religious Liberty #227**

Pope Francis has stated that religious freedom is a  
fundamental human right. Each individual must be  
free, alone or in association with others, to seek  
the truth, and to openly express his or her religious  
convictions, free from intimidation and external  
compulsion. Genuine worship of God bears fruit  
not in discrimination, hatred and violence, but in  
respect for the sacredness of life, respect for the  
dignity and freedom of others, and loving  
commitment to the welfare of all. It is protected in  
the First Amendment of the Bill of Rights of our  
U.S. Constitution. *If you haven't done so already,  
please voice your opposition to the federal health care  
mandate by calling U.S. Secretary of Health and  
Human Services Sylvia Mathews Burwell at 202-205-  
5445, and your elected representatives. Let them know  
that the mandate is in violation of our First  
Amendment right to religious freedom. If you have  
called, call again, our representatives need to pay  
attention.*
