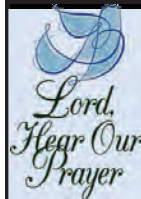

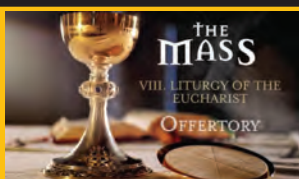
## HOMEBOUND? HOSPITALIZED?



Please be aware that privacy laws prevent hospitals and nursing homes from informing us about patients in their care. We no longer are al-

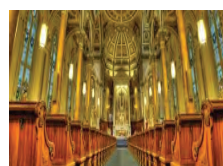

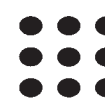
