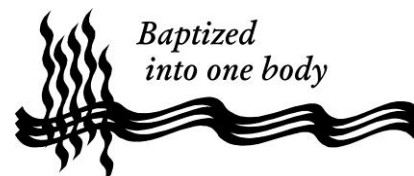

Evangelization Corner At this culmination of the Easter season, let us unite in a great chorus of praise in the Spirit, who is the life-breath of the whole world made new in the Death and Resurrection of Christ.

Are you interested in purchasing a Brick to add to our "BRICK WALK & PATIO?" Your purchase of a brick can be a lasting memorial to a loved one, an expression of thanksgiving for blessings received or can be used to leave your family members names as an expression of your support and love for Holy Name of Jesus Parish. *This project was first conceived as a means to raise much needed funds to support critical building and grounds repairs to our beautiful Holy Name of Jesus campus. A Maintenance and Repair Fund was set up supported by all proceeds from this project which has raised to date a total of nearly \$100,000. Over the past nine years the bulk of these proceeds have been spent on such repairs as a new roof on the school, repairs to classrooms due to water damage, sidewalk repair, roof and exterior repairs to the Church building, replacement of the Convent water heater and School boiler, repairs to the organ pipes and walls in the choir loft due to water damage, new Hall doors, chimney repairs on the Rectory, and many additional smaller projects. As is evident, the maintenance and repairs to five campus buildings are an ongoing necessity as the buildings continue to age.* **We will be accepting orders for additional bricks through the month of June.
